New Zealand has an incredibly diverse range of flora, consisting of more than 2200 different species of native plants. The evolution and development of many of these has been quite unique over the centuries, due in part to New Zealand’s ancient history as a land that was once joined to both Australia and South America, yet over millions of years drifted away to become a separate and increasingly isolated landmass far away from all other continents. As a result, its plants and wildlife have been subject to a unique combination of evolutionary influences, resulting in rare phytochemical & therapeutic profiles.

Phil is passionate about facilitating greater understanding of the pharmacology of our native species, as well as providing a scientific basis towards their known traditional, modern herbalist or as yet unknown potential medicinal uses. These can make a significant contribution to the healthcare of current and future generations, in a fast-changing world.

This seminar provides an excellent opportunity for herbal practitioners and students of herbal medicine to increase their knowledge of the medicinal uses of New Zealand native plants.
